Glentress King Othe Road (Adams) and Reserve Bitch to Ch. Glentress Ican Coz Iam (Adams) a full-sister to the Challenge Bitch winner from a repeat mating.

There have been a number of new titles for the month: Kicking off in NSW, congratulations to Ch. Nahrof Madison Avenue "Blair" owned by Margaret Aldous on gaining her title. Blair is the 5th champion for her sire, Ch. Wiralee Wild World and the 2nd champion for her dam, Ch. Nahrof Ghost of Chance ADX JDX.

In Victoria, congratulations to Ch. Ballyann Tartn At Midnite, "Sassy" owned by Allison Glover and John and Joyce Sullivan on gaining her title at Sunshine Kennel Club with Best of Breed and Junior in Show. She is sired by Ch/NZ Ch. Nominations for Committee

It's that time of the year again to call for nominations for the club's committee for the upcoming year. All positions become vacant at the Annual General Meeting on 9th September 2008. The club needs your help and also needs new ideas and people. If you can help and are able to give up some of your free time for the upcoming 12 months then please fill in the nomination form on the following page and nominate for a position on the committee for the 2008-2009 year. To give you an idea of what the responsibilities are for each of the positions there is a brief job description shown below.

President – Chair meetings, open and close shows/trials and act as master of ceremonies; represents the club at functions when requested to do so by the committee; take over duties or accepts responsibility of transferring those duties to another member.

Vice President – Stand in for the President in the event of his/her absence.

Secretary – attend to all club's correspondence; carry out duties in accordance with the requirements of the RNSWCC, and club's constitution and handle general club inquiries.

Assistant Secretary – Record minutes of all club and committee meetings; supply copy of minutes to President, Secretary, and Treasurer, stand in for the secretary in his/her absence.

Treasurer – Carry out duties in accordance with the club's constitution, including handle all of the funds of the club and ensuring that all accounts are paid.

Publicity Officer – Collate, print (or arrange for printing to be done) and send out Newsletter as requires; prepare any other printing as requested by the club.

Show Secretary/Trial Secretary – Contract judges; submit draft show/trial schedule and advertising to the RNSWCC at least 6 months prior to show/trial; if required, arrange accommodation and transport for the judges; receive and catalogue entries; send out entry cards at least ten days before show/trial; arrange for vetting officer for trial; obtain and complete all documentation as required by affiliates constitutions and send to Canine Council; provide Publicity Officer with marked catalogue after show/trial; organise any critique arrangements as requested by the club; provide memento to the judges.

Show Manager/Trial Manager – Arrange stewards; arrange with caretaker erection and subsequent dismantling of directional signs in street; organize parking arrangements including an attendant; liaise with Show/Trial Manager regarding the ring placement; ensure that all rings and equipment are dismantled and put away after the show/trial; assist the Show/Trial secretary and, if necessary, arrange for an erected tent to be provided for Show/Trial Secretary; entertain judges when they arrive; arrange and instruct photographer and/or video cameraman; ensure grounds are left clean and tidy after show/trial and that grounds and buildings are locked as prior to show/trial.

Trophy Steward – Record all notifications of show, obedience, tracking and endurance title throughout the year; purchase title and point awards; purchase trophies for show/trial; if required, select another member to confer in trophy selection; endeavor to secure sponsorship for the show/trial.

Property Officer – Store and maintain club's property, including Club's photographic records but excluding promotional items.

General Committee - Be an active member of the committee, lending a hand wherever required and taking on incidental positions as they arise.

The Club held our annual Tracking Trial at Erskine Park on Sunday 29th June. Four tracks were laid and run – the participants were two Border Collies and two German Shepherds. The judge for this event was well known BC lover Tiki Friezer.

Unfortunately, there was only one successful team on the day which was Vicky Etherington and her Border Collie "Country" who had a great day – successfully completing Track 6 and thereby fulfilling the requirements necessary to obtain their *TRACKING CHAMPIONSHIP* – it was great that this coveted award was won at our own club trial! Well done to Vicky and "Country" – now known as Tracking Ch Nahrof Country Music HT ET CDX.

Obedience Point Score

Purpose of Competition

To encourage the handlers and dogs to achieve a consistent high standard in the obedience area, and be rewarded with recognition for their time and efforts

Format of Competition

Each class has its own point score, i.e. Novice, Open and Utility. Handlers are required to submit the following;

- 1. Qualifying scores (total of three) for the desired class
- 2. The qualifying scores must be achieved by the handler working his own dog.
- 3. The 3 scores must be achieved by the same dog.
- 4. Only 1 score card may be submitted under a particular judge. In the event of multiple exhibits owned/worked by the same handler each dog is required in their total of 3 scores to have achieved these under 3 different judges.
- 5. Competitors must be financial members of the BCC of NSW Inc prior to the date of the earliest calendar dated qualifying score submitted, and must remain financial members of the BCC of NSW Inc during the running of the competition.
- 6. The twelve month qualifying period will commence from 1 September 2007 and cease on 31 August 2008.
- 7. In the event of a tied point score, the exhibitors will be asked to submit a further qualifying card until a winner is determined.
- 9. Photocopies of the qualifying cards must be sent to the **Secretary**, **Border Collie Club of NSW by 14 September 2008**.
- 10. A summary of the aggregates for each class will be published in the next available Bordertales and awards made as soon as possible.
- 11. The decision of the Committee is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 12. Failure of the competitor to fulfil all the criteria listed above will render their entry null and void.
- 13. This competition does not require and entry fee.

The 2007/2008 competition is now underway with the qualifying period being 1 September 2007 to 31 August 2008. Competition rules will be published at frequent intervals in Bordertales.
